This is the office website of the State of Indiana, and it has a wealth of information on our Indiana government.

If you visit this site, you will find links to your legislator's own website and e-mail address. (Just type in your zipcode!). In addition, you will find the status of all bills, who is assigned to committees, scheduled meetings of committees, the House and Senate calendars, and much, much more.

If you are not currently connected to the internet, many libraries now provide public access free of charge. They will gladly demonstrate how easy it is to use.

E-MAIL

This is a very quick way to send a letter to your legislator. Follow the procedure as suggested in the handout, “How to E-Mail your Legislator”. All of our legislators receive a desktop computer from the state of Indiana and can be reached via e-mail. Some use this method of communication more than others, so the first time you send an e-mail, make sure you ask for a response.
